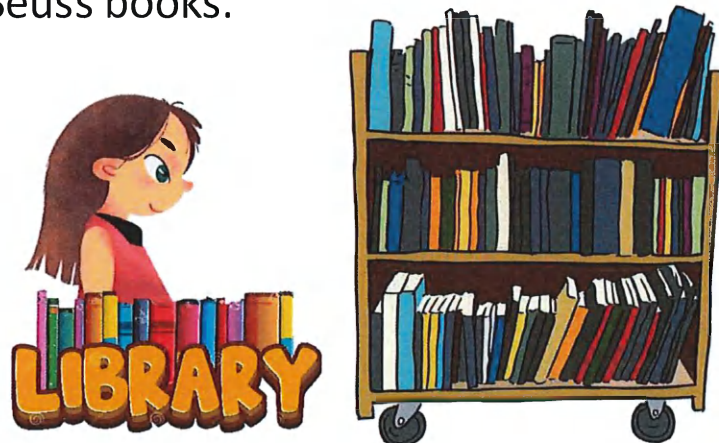


Lesson learnt at Library
